Fats, Oils, Creams	Blot and press with tissue paper, carpet shampoo
Egg, milk	Luke-warm water
Blood	Soak up with cold water and a little ammonia
Coffee, chocolate	Luke warm water with carpet shampoo
Coca Cola, Tea	Blot immediately, carpet shampoo and water
Fruit juices	Luke-warm water, mild detergent, rinse well With a mild vinegar solution (½ cup vinegar/3 cups water)
Wax	Press hot iron over layers of tissue paper to blot up Liquid wax.
Urine	Blot to soak up as much as possible. Soak with cold Water, and then rinse with mild vinegar solution.
Beer	Blot, use carpet shampoo and rinse with vinegar Solution.
Red wine	Sprinkle salt generously to absorb. Vacuum away. Then use carpet shampoo.
Ink	Soak with ½ cup water/1/2 cup milk solution and Rinse well.
Soot	Vacuum, then dab with turpentine. Spot shampoo If desired.
Vomit	Remove all solids by scraping carefully with spatula or knife, from outer edge inwards. Spot wash with Carpet shampoo and rinse with mild vinegar solution.
Paint	Check paint for emulsifier, spot-apply lukewarm Water and rinse out well, or dab with acetone and Rinse with Luke warm water.
Stools	Scrape off solids from outer edge inwards, carpet Shampoo, rinse well with plenty water and mild Vinegar solution.
